Adult Faith Formation News

The liturgical season of Lent is offered by the Church as a time of **reflection** and **introspection.** We look inward at where we are in our spiritual growth, building on our strengths and refining our weaknesses as we prepare to celebrate Holy Week. To help in that process, we often use various sources to inspire our reflection.

Some sources are of the **do-it-yourself** variety. This year, we again have the "Little Black Books" to offer daily meditations for each day of Lent, starting with Ash Wednesday. Each day offers you a new reflection, ordinarily tying the Sunday gospel to another aspect of our Catholic faith and tradition. You can build on this linkage to reflect on your own situation and prayer life. These books are available at the churches today, since they start on Ash Wednesday.

Liturgical sources will also support you. For Ash Wednesday, Mass and ashes times are given elsewhere in this bulletin. Times for Friday's Stations of the Cross and extra Confession times are also listed.

Sometimes we seek **educational** resources to stimulate our growth. Our regular bible study group continues to meet Tuesday mornings. Added resources this year will include a new series offered by Fr. Joe on alternate Tuesday evenings. **"Go Ask Your Father!"** will begin March 6 and 20.

I will begin a series of **biweekly programs** on Thursday evenings, repeated on Friday mornings (rather like the format we used with the "Biblical Walk Through the Liturgy" program this past fall). Specific topics will be announced in the bulletin ahead of time. We'll alternate weeks with Father's series, so you can have some program available each week. My March sessions, for example, will be on March 1/2, 15/16, and 29/30.

May these resources help you grow your faith toward the Easter celebration!

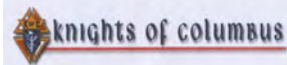

**Lenten Regulations On
 Fasting And Abstinence**

 1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.
 2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may only eat one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
 3. These minimal penitential practices should not be lightly excused.
